Available Chairmanships

Co-General:

Assist the General Chairman and the other chairmen with their responsibilities. Should understand the importance and efficiency of delegating and communicating with the members. Expect many early mornings and late nights. The Co-General will become the General Chair next year.

Grounds:

Setup and takedown of the barns, fences, tents, and signage. Keep the grounds clean during the show. Operate skid steers, tractors, and forklifts.

Milk House:

Two people will be required to operate the milk house and organize milk can runs. Record weights, sample milk, and maintain sanitary conditions. This is a two year term.

Business:

Coordinate worker hours, drive workers to and from the Expo grounds, make sure all time sheets and tax forms are filled out properly. Must be able to obtain driver authorization from the University.

Showring:

Responsible for coordinating the setup and takedown of the showring, as well as maintaining the showring during the shows.

Cheese Stand:

Operate the club's largest fundraiser. Ordering supplies, organizing work crew. This is a two year term.

Storage:

Transport supplies from the storage lockers to the Expo grounds before and during the show. Return to storage and organize items following the show.
